Swanage Railway

The Swanage Railway is a picturesque heritage railway, running to Corfe Castle and back through the countryside.



This information is intended as a guide for visitors who are joining us on one of our Dorset journeys. We strongly encourage those with specific access needs to contact us at tickets@foxandedwards.com so that we can make provisions for your journey to be as easy and enjoyable as possible.

Car Parking

There is a local authority Pay & Display car park, with disabled bays, around 300m away from the station.

Additionally there is another council car park adjacent to the station which has a 2-hour time limit. This car park may not allow enough time for your visit.

Access to the Platform

All platforms at the Swanage Railway have step free access.

Toilets

Ladies & Gentlemen toilets are located at the station.

The nearest accessible toilet is approximately 200m along Rempstone Road, towards the sea.

Boarding & Disembarking the Train

Access ramps are available from platform staff to assist with boarding and disembarking the train.

On Board the Train

The railway does not currently have a specially converted carriage for wheelchair users.

Wheelchair users who can transfer from their seat once on board the train can be boarded in the Guard's Compartment and make their way to a nearby seat.

All of our journeys are return and therefore you will be back at the same station as you departed from.
