### Car Parking

Car parking is available at Bo'ness Station. There is a large car park which is tarmac surface on the roadway areas and gravel in the parking spaces. Some spaces are close to the station entrance, however visitors may wish to drop off those with accessibility requirements near to the station building before parking at busy times.

### Access to the Railway

There is step free access to the platforms from the station building. The cafe, gift shop and museum are wheelchair friendly.

### Toilets

An accessible toilet is available at Bo'ness Station. There are limited toilet facilities on board the train. There are no toilets at Manuel Station.

### Boarding & Disembarking the Train

Staff have ramps readily available to assist boarding the train.

### On Board the Train

The railway have a specially adapted wheelchair accessible coach. Please contact us in advance of your booking so that we can check that there is availability.

### After Your Journey

All of our journeys are return and therefore you will be back at the same station as your departure.
