Accessibility Guide

Ecclesbourne Valley Railway Derbyshire

Wirksworth Station, DE4 4FB

The Ecclesbourne Valley Railway is Derbyshire's longest heritage railway, taking its name from the river which runs alongside.


Car Parking

There is a large car park at the station which is flat, however it can get quite busy. There are a small number of disabled spaces outside the station entrance. It is advised that those with accessibility needs can be dropped outside the Booking Office if disabled spaces are occupied.

Access to the Platforms

There is step-free access to the platforms, museum, gift shops and toilets. The Station Cafe is located inside a converted railway carriage with limited wheelchair access whilst a new station building is constructed.

Access to Platform 2, where we regularly board, is via a foot crossing across the track which is level but a little uneven.



Toilets

Fully accessible toilets are available at Wirksworth & Duffield Stations.

There are toilets available on board the train, however they may be in another carriage.

Boarding & Disembarking the Train

Wirksworth & Duffield Stations both feature modern regulation height platforms with one small step up on to the train.

Staff have ramps readily available to assist for both wheelchairs and those who struggle to step up.

On Board the Train

All of the carriages are comfortable and spacious.

The railway has a beautifully restored carriage which has an adaptation that can carry two wheelchair passengers with up to two guests each with them. This area is in the same coach as other passengers. Please contact us early to discuss availability of these spaces so that we can book them for you.

All of our journeys are return and therefore you will be back at the same station as you departed from.
