so that we can make provisions for your journey to be as easy and enjoyable as possible. This information is intended as a guide for visitors who are joining us on one of our South Wales journeys.

Car Parking

There is a brand new huge free car park at the Abergwili Junction site which is level but of rough stone surface.

A number of spaces near to the platform entrance are reserved for disabled visitors. It is also possible to drop off persons with accessibility needs outside the platforms prior to parking the car.

Access to the Railway

Access to the platforms is step free.

Abergwili Junction station is still under construction and many of the facilities are temporary, which may currently limit access.

The Cafe is formed of two former railway carriage bodies joined together which has ramp access, but narrow aisles inside. There is no outdoor covered accommodation for visitors.

Toilets

An accessible toilet is available at Abergwili Junction Station.

There are limited toilet facilities available on board the train.

Boarding & Disembarking the Train

As the station is a new construction, the platforms are built to the modern platform height. Ramps are available to assist with boarding.

On Board the Train

The coaches are comfortable and spacious inside.

There is an area on board the train for wheelchair passengers to embark and disembark. It is not a suitable area for passengers to ride in so a wheelchair user will need to transfer to nearby seating. The railway are currently working on upgrading their wheelchair accommodation.
