Car Parking

Car parking is available at Alresford Station. It is Pay & Display. There are designated accessible bays.

The car park can get very busy so visitors may wish to drop off those with accessibility requirements near to the station entrance before parking the car.

Access to the Railway

There is step free access to the platforms from the station building. There is also ramp access to cross platforms.

Toilets

An accessible toilet is available at Alresford Station.

There are limited toilet facilities on board the train.

Boarding & Disembarking the Train

Staff have ramps readily available to assist boarding the train.

On Board the Train

The railway have specially adapted wheelchair accessible coaches. Please contact us in advance of your booking so that we can check that there is availability.
