This information is intended as a guide for visitors who are joining us on one of our Sussex journeys. We strongly encourage those with specific access needs to contact us at tickets@foxandedwards.com so that we can make provisions for your journey to be as easy and enjoyable as possible.

Car Parking

There is a large car park at Sheffield Park Station. There are designated accessible bays near to the station building however they can get busy. We suggest that those persons with mobility are dropped off outside the station and then the car parked in the regular car park.

There is step free access to the platforms and other facilities including the gift shop and Bessemer Arms pub/restaurant.

Toilets

An accessible toilet is available at Sheffield Park Station.
