



# Accessibility Guide

## Great Central Railway Nottingham

### Nottingham Transport Heritage Centre, NG11 6JS

The Great Central Railway Nottingham runs from Ruddington Fields to just outside of Loughborough, a distance of 10 miles each direction.

This information is intended as a guide for visitors joining us at the GCR(N).

### Car Parking

There is a large on-site car park with car parking near to the platform those with accessible needs. Volunteers may ask for a donation to the society.

### Access to Platforms

Platform access is flat from the car park.

The platform surface and height is good, with the surface made of paving stones and minimal gap between the train and the platform edge.

### Boarding & Disembarking the Train

Ramp access is available to a seating area for a wheelchair and two guests in the Guards area. The railway are working to provide an upgraded conversion soon.



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### Toilets

Toilet facilities are located on the opposite side of the car park to the platform. Further facilities, including a new accessible toilet, are towards the other end of the heritage centre.

On train toilets are operational at various intervals throughout the train.

### On Board the Train

Due to the age of the heritage carriages and their fixed seating, wheelchairs and mobility scooters cannot be seated in the main carriages.

The main carriages are entered through a narrow doorway with two narrow steps.

### After Your Journey

All of our journeys return to the same station which you departed from.
